

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh,
New York, held February 16th, 1945.

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 of 1945.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Sections 3 and 7 of Local Law No. 7 of 1943, by providing for a seven percent (7%) increase in the salaries of certain positions listed under said Sections 3 and 7, said increase to continue for the duration of World War No. 2 and for a period of six months thereafter.

SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1945, the annual salary attached to the positions of "Assistant Librarian", and "Library Clerk", listed under Section 3 of Local Law No. 7 of 1943, shall be increased by seven percent (7%), said increase to be regarded as war emergency compensation and to continue in force for the duration of World War No. 2 and for a period of six months thereafter.


SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 1945, the annual salary attached to the position of "Motor Equipment Operator" under Section 7 of Local Law No. 7 of 1943, shall be increased by seven percent (7%), said increase to be regarded as war emergency compensation and to continue in force for the duration of World War No. 2 and for a period of six months thereafter.

SECTION 3. No part of the additional war emergency compensation received under this act shall be regarded as salary or compensation for any of the purposes of any pension or retirement system in which the officer or employee receiving the same is a member, and the receipt of such additional compensation shall not be deemed to change the basic compensation of any such officer or employee for the purpose of computing a pension retirement allowance, death benefit, contribution in connection with such membership, or for the purpose of determining any other right or privilege resulting from or appertaining to such membership, or for the purpose of determining the right to any increase of salary or any salary increment. No such additional compensation shall be construed to constitute a promotion or to increase any compensation which a public employee may receive pursuant to Section Two Hundred Forty-five of the Military Law.


SECTION 4. This Law shall take effect as of January 1st, 1945, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Gervais, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary, Spinks and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative,
