LOCAL LAW NO. 10 OF 1942.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 141 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as last amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1938, in relation to the designation of Acting City Judge, duties thereof and compensation therefor.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh,

That Section 141, Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, Entitled an Act To Incorporate The City of Plattsburgh, New York, as amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1938, and as so amended, be further amended to read as follows:

Section 141. Acting City Judge, designation of, compensation. The Mayor shall designate in writing, to be filed with the City Clerk, an Attorney and Counselor-At-Law residing within the City of Plattsburgh, New York, who shall, only during the sickness, absence from the City, disability or inability of the City Judge to act, exercise in the place and stead of the City Judge, all the powers of said Judge, including jurisdiction in cases then pending before the said City Judge. designation shall terminate at the expiration of the term of office of the then City Judge. The compensation of the Acting City Judge shall be such as the Common Council shall determine, not exceeding the sum of \$5.00 per diem for every day not exceeding sixty days in any calendar year actually spent in the discharge of the duties of the Acting City Judge, claims therefor when submitted from time to time, to be audited, allowed and paid by the Common Council upon presentation by such Acting City Judge of a verified statement of account for services so rendered. Claims for any additional services, other than as herein provided, shall be presented to the Common Council, and if allowed, shall be deducted

This Local Law shall take effect July 1st, 1942.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Giolosa, Demary, Behan and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative.
