LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 1954.

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW ABOLISHING THE BOARD OF HEALTH AND THE VARIOUS POSITIONS IN THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AND REPEALING TITLE 8, SECTION 114 OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902, AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1949.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Board of Health Abolished. The Board of Health of the City of Plattsburgh is hereby abolished as of April 1, 1954.


Section 2. Positions Abolished. The position of health officer, public health nurse, school nurse, senior clerk, junior clerk, milk inspector and pediatrician are hereby abolished as of April 1, 1954.

Section 3. Laws Repealed. Title 8, Section 114 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 is hereby repealed.


Section 4. Time of Taking Effect. This Law shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
