LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1967.

A LOCAL LAW REPEALING LOCAL LAWS NUMBERS  
4 AND 12 OF 1966 AND AMENDING SECTION  
141 OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902  
AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NUMBER 40 OF  
1949.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

SECTION 1: Local Laws Numbers 4 and 12 of 1966 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Section 141 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended by Local Law Number 40 of 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:


"Section 141 - The Mayor shall designate, in writing, to be filed with the City Clerk, an Attorney and Counselor at Law, residing within the City of Plattsburgh, who shall, during sickness, absence from the City, disability or inability of the City Judge to act, exercise in the place and stead of the City Judge, all the powers of said Judge, including cases then pending before said Judge. In such cases it shall be upon the written direction of the City Judge. In the event of the inability of the Acting City Judge to act, for any of the reasons above enumerated, the Mayor shall designate another Attorney and Counselor at Law, to act as City Judge until the City Judge or Acting City Judge are able to perform their duties."

SECTION 3: The salary of the Acting City Judge or second Acting City Judge shall be paid at the rate of ~~FIFTY~~ Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per day but only for time actually spent on the bench, and in no event to exceed TwelveHundred (\$1200.00) Dollars for both Acting City Judges, inclusive, in one year, the same to be paid on voucher and audited by the City Judge.


SECTION 4: This Act shall take effect February 1st., 1967,  
after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.
