Local Law No. 2 of the year 2018

A local law amending Chapter 86, Sections 2 and 3 of the City Code of the City of Plattsburgh.

City Code § 86-2 is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

The Planning Board shall consist of five regular members and two alternate members. The alternate members shall serve only in the absence of a regular member, or where a regular member is unable to vote on a matter due to conflict of interest considerations.

City Code § 86-3 shall be re-named "Appointments; Term; Quorum" and is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

The Mayor shall appoint the regular and alternate members of the Planning Board, subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of three members of the Common Council. The Mayor shall attempt to appoint at least one regular member or alternate member from each Ward. The Planning Board shall elect annually, a chairperson from its own regular members. No member of the Common Council or the Zoning Board of Appeals of the City of Plattsburgh shall be eligible for appointment to the Planning Board. A Board member may be removed from office by vote of the Common Council if he or she fails to attend five or more Board meetings out of twelve consecutive regular or special meetings of the Board. The terms of regular and alternate members shall expire on December 31st in the year when the term for which they were appointed expires. A member whose term expires may continue to serve until a successor is appointed. A person who is appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve until the expiration of the term of the person who vacated the position. The term of a member shall be five years, however, if two or more

terms expire in the same year appointments to one or more of the regular positions shall be made for less than five years so that one position becomes vacant every five years. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the whole board.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Mayor and filing with the New York Secretary of State.
