The City sends different organic wastes to landfills including food/paper waste and wastewater treatment biosolids. The solid waste disposal market, and biosolids in particular, is under a lot of pressure and prices are skyrocketing. There are signs that it could get worse. The City could also end up seeing requirements that households must separate their food and paper waste from their normal trash. I've been looking for ways to try to ensure the long term reliability and economic affordability for our biosolids and learned of an EPA Request For Application (RFA) for providing grants to pursue the anaerobic digestion (AD) of food waste and other organic materials diverted from landfills. Applications are due July 14th and we're scrambling to try to pull one together to study the potential for using AD to process food/paper waste and other organics.

One of the application requirements is authorization to submit it. Also, there is no match requirement but applications that leverage other funding sources score more points. I'm expecting the cost for the study to be less than \$200,000 so a \$10,000 City contribution will probably make the application more competitive.

Therefore, in accordance with the request, the Environmental Manager is authorized to prepare and submit an application to EPA for its "Sustainable Materials Management 2020 Anaerobic Digestion Funding Opportunity" and sign all necessary documents. It is further agreed that up to \$10,000 from the Sewer Fund may be identified in the application as leveraged funds.
