WHEREAS, the City of Plattsburgh is the Owner of the improved real property located at 6 Miller Street in the City of Plattsburgh (Tax Map No. 207.16.2-42) (hereafter "Miller Street Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Miller Street Property was formerly used by the City's MLD for office space but the Miller Street Property has remained vacant for approximately four years following the MLD's office relocation; and

WHEREAS, the Miller Street Property, which is not a parkland or otherwise inalienable, currently serves no municipal purpose and is unlikely to serve a municipal purpose in the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, the City has engaged with CDC to serve as its broker in an attempt to market and convey the Miller Street Property; and

WHEREAS, CDC, through its marketing efforts, has received an offer on behalf of the City to purchase the Miller Street Property, which it has relayed to the City.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City incorporates all recitations above by reference, and in accordance with the request therefore, the Mayor is authorized to sign and deliver a Purchase and Sale Agreement, Deed and other conveyance documents, in a form approved by the City Attorney, to convey the real property identified herein as the Miller Street Property to Jay Corell, or their assigns, in the amount of \$229,000, less customary closing costs and broker fees. The consideration to be received by the City is fair and reasonable based on the cost savings to the City, the market value of the property, and the length of time it has been on the market.
